

SEMA TEACHING AND SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Resolved that SEMA will create an Award for Teaching Excellence and two Awards for Scholarly Achievement to recognize outstanding contributions to these fields by its members.

Nominations may be made for the above awards by fellow members of SEMA in good standing, by colleagues or by self application. The criteria for these awards are as follows:

For the Award for Teaching Excellence: (\$200 gift certificate from Scholars Choice)

1. A selection of student evaluations for three years
2. Letters of support from colleagues and/or Deans or students
3. A brief narrative describing the nominee's teaching philosophy
4. A list of courses taught in the medieval area for the past three years
5. *A curriculum vitae*

For the Award for Scholarly Achievement: (\$200 gift certificate from Scholars Choice)

1. A substantial number of publications, books and/or articles, or a combination of the two in a field of medieval scholarship; at least one publication must have appeared in *Medieval Perspectives*.
2. Letters of support from colleagues and/or Deans or students
3. *A curriculum vitae*

For the Award for Best First Book: (\$100 gift certificate from Scholars Press)

1. A book in a field of medieval scholarship
2. Letters of support from colleagues and/or Deans or students
3. *A curriculum vitae*

The Selection Committee for these awards will be composed of members of the Executive Council of SEMA.
